

LEGAL NOTICE

A certified list of Republican party-endorsed candidates for the Town of Fairfield for election as members of the Town Committee from the following districts is on file in my office at 611 Old Post Road, Fairfield, Connecticut and copies are available for public distribution.

The number of Town Committee members to be elected, under party rules, and the number of names of candidates included in the certificate from each district specified is as follows:

A primary will be held March 1, 2022, in each of the above districts in which candidacies numbering at least 25% of the number of Town Committee members to be elected by such party in such district are filed in accordance with §9-382 to §9-450, inclusive, of the General Statutes by persons other than party-endorsed candidates not later than 4:00 P.M. of January 26, 2022, provided the number of such candidacies, plus the number of endorsed candidates for such district, exceeds the number of town committee members to be elected. (If the number of opposing candidacies filed is reduced to less than such 25% in any district, no primary will be held). Petition forms, instructions, and information concerning the procedure for filing opposing candidacies may be obtained from Stephen C. Elworthy, Republican Registrar of Voters, 611 Old Post Road, Fairfield, Connecticut.
