I. Call to order

Hal Schwartz called to order the meeting of the RTM Redistricting Committee at 7:03pm on March 22, 2022

III. Agenda

1) To consider and act upon the minutes from the Meeting held on March 15, 2022

- Motion to approve, moved by Representative McCormack, seconded by Representative Wackerman, motion passed unanimously

2) Finalize Maps

- Representative McCormack stated that she was not prepared to vote on the maps drafted by the Committee at this meeting because she required more information. She requested the voter enrollment tabulation breakout report for November 2021
- Representative Iacono requested the Voter Registration list as of March 1, 2022 and that the population numbers to be added to the census blocks on the party affiliation town-wide map as drafted on March 15. Mr. Waggner provided Representative Iacono the requested map at the meeting.
- No votes were taken to finalize maps

3) Number of RTM Representatives Discussion

- The Committee began discussing whether there should be a recommendation to change the ordinance from 4 members per district to a different, possible lower number of representatives per district. No votes were taken.

4) To Consider a redistricting ordinance to be presented to the RTM at its April 25th meeting.
