I. Call to order

III. Agenda

1) To consider and act upon the minutes from the Meeting held on March 15, 2022

- Motion to approve, moved by Representative McCormack, seconded by Representative Schwartz. Representative Wackerman, offered two clarifying amendments which were accepted by the Committee, motion passed unanimously

2) Finalize Maps

- Representatives Iacono and McCormack expressed a desire to wait to hear more from the outcome of Charter Reform before continuing with the adoption of a draft 10 district map. Representatives Schwartz and Wackerman disagreed. There was a discussion about the merits of pausing for Charter Reform and the merits of continuing to make the agenda for the April RTM meeting. Representatives Schwartz and Wackerman opposed recessing the Committee.
- Having no majority consensus, no votes were taken to finalize maps
