

Harbor Management Commission Mooring Committee  
May 10, 2022

The Harbor Management Commission's Mooring Committee met at Sullivan Independence Hall on May 10, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. Attending: Kim Taylor, Jac Herschler, Bill Perugini, Jeff Warren, Geoff Steadman, and Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc.

Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc reported all harbor moorings are now in place. Four permit applicants are still pending due to outstanding required documents. Harbor Master LeClerc has assigned the Perry Green moorings that are administered by the Harbor Master. He expects to receive the Perry Green mooring assignments that are made by the Parks and Recreation Department shortly. The Harbor Master reported that the mooring waiting list has had 12 new applications since last November.

The committee discussed the job description for the Deputy Harbor Master role and reached consensus that it will recommend to the full Harbor Management Commission that the description simply say the Deputy Harbor Master, at the direction of the Harbor Master, may be delegated any of the responsibilities outlined in the Harbor Master job description. The required skills and experience would be the same as those required of a Harbor Master. Chair Kim Taylor will present this recommendation to the full Harbor Management Commission.
