

Harbor Management Commission Mooring Committee

July 12, 2022

The Harbor Management Commission's Mooring Committee met at Sullivan Independence Hall on July 12, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. Attending: Kim Taylor, Jac Herschler, Bill Perugini, Jeff Warren, and Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc.

Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc reported two mooring vacancies recently occurred which allowed him to assign those mooring locations to two vessels from the top of the waiting list. He also reported he is tracking docked vessel information reporting as required by the mooring rules and procedures.

The Harbor Master advised the committee that he is working with Justin Cathcart to address two situations where vessels at Ye Yacht Yard are not properly registered. There is also a boat that is too large to be at YYY, and another boat that is not permitted to be tied up at YYY.

Finally, Harbor Master LeClerc reported that a PYC Ideal 18 accidentally hit the stern of a moored powerboat resulting in property damage. Fairfield Marine Police responded to the incident. There were no injuries.

Jac Herschler reported on a preliminary conversation with Justin Cathcart and Bryan LeClerc about potentially transferring responsibility for administering 9 Perry Green mooring locations from the Parks and Recreation Department to the Harbor Master and Harbor Management Commission. That conversation was inconclusive.
