

Harbor Management Commission Mooring Committee

August 9, 2022

The Harbor Management Commission's Mooring Committee met by conference call on August 9, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. Attending: Kim Taylor, Jac Herschler, Bill Perugini, Jeff Warren, Geoff Steadman, and Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc.

Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc reported all moorings have been assigned. He is monitoring the catch reports of the permit holder who obtained his mooring permit by asserting he is a commercial fisherman. He also reported that Pequot Yacht Club is keeping records on the vessels using the moorings in the North Anchorage and indicated that new record keeping method is working well.

The Harbor Master reported there are cases of vessels not on assigned moorings, but the owners are comfortable with the situations until they can be corrected. He also indicated he and the Fairfield Police are monitoring to ensure children are not diving into the harbor or swimming in the navigation channel.

The committee discussed next steps in the recruiting process for candidates to serve as Deputy Harbor Master.

The committee discussed an issue with document image files in the Online Mooring system not consistently appearing. The software vendor is currently investigating the issue,
