

Harbor Management Commission Mooring Committee  
September 13, 2022

The Harbor Management Commission's Mooring Committee met at Sullivan Independence Hall on September 13, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. Attending: Kim Taylor, Jac Herschler, Bill Perugini, Jeff Warren, and Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc. Geoff Steadman was absent.

Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc reported that he identified several cases of improper attachment of vessels to their moorings. Mooring permit holders have been informed if their boats were found to be improperly secured. One boat recently bumped the boat behind it due to being improperly tied.

The Harbor Master reported the new system requiring Pequot Yacht Club to keep records for vessels using North Anchorage moorings has worked well this season. He also reported that Pequot Yacht Club has done a good job of supporting the transient moorings for visiting boaters.

The Harbor Master suggested that we communicate with the Fairfield Country Club manager about children swimming from the country club side of the harbor. The committee agreed with this recommendation.

Pat Carroll, representing the public, endorsed the suggestion to speak with the country club manager about the dangers of swimming in the harbor,
