

Harbor Management Commission Mooring Committee

March 14, 2023

The Harbor Management Commission's Mooring Committee met at Sullivan Independence Hall on March 14, 2023 at 5:30 p.m. Attending: Kim Taylor, Jac Herschler, Jeff Warren, Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc and Bill Perugini. Geoff Steadman was absent.

Harbor Master Bryan LeClerc reported that five permit renewals still are pending due to missing vessel registrations and/or insurance policy declarations pages. One, and possibly two wall moorings will be available to be assigned from the waiting list for the coming season. In addition, there are two vacant slips at Pequot Yacht Club that may be assigned by the club to boaters who currently hold a town mooring permit. If so, one or two additional helix mooring locations may also open up for assignment from the waiting list. The Harbor Master expects to hear more about the PYC's vacant slip assignments very soon.

The Harbor Master reported that he met with the Town IT Director and the town's video surveillance vendor at Ye Yacht Yard to evaluate whether monitoring cameras could be installed at that site. The Harbor Master said we will be receiving a proposal from the vendor to install two video cameras.

The committee discussed the idea of reallocating responsibility for management of certain Perry Green mooring locations from the Parks and Recreation Department to the Harbor Management Commission.

The committee was updated by Bill Perugini regarding the status of interviewing Deputy Harbor Master candidates.
