8. To hear, consider and act upon the following resolutions as recommended by the Board of Finance:

"RESOLVED, that, in accordance with a request from the Police Chief, a grant agreement between the Connecticut Department of Transportation Highway Safety Office and the Town of Fairfield for the Fairfield Police Department's Distracted Driving High Visibility Enforcement Program be, and hereby is, approved; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that acceptance of the grant funds and their appropriation for the purposes set forth in the grant agreement be, and hereby are, approved."

9. To hear, consider and act upon the following resolution as recommended by the Board of Finance:

"WHEREAS, the Town of Fairfield ("Town") and the CONNECTICUT METROPOLITAN COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS ("MetroCOG") have been awarded a grant in the total amount of \$5,000 from the Connecticut Department of Transportation's Active Transportation Microgrant Program for Fairfield's "Safer Streets" Program; and

WHEREAS, the Grant money will be used for a public awareness campaign sponsored by the Fairfield Safe Streets Alliance to increase awareness of dangerous driving and encourage behavior change by all roadway users;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the First Selectman be, and hereby is, authorized to accept said Grant, expend said Grant funds in accordance with the terms of the Grant, and execute any and all required documents to effectuate said Grant."

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10. To hear, consider and act upon the following resolution as recommended by the Board of Finance:

“RESOLVED, that that the Town of Fairfield, by its First Selectman, William A. Gerber, is authorized to enter into a ground lease for 75 years with Habitat for Humanity to build four units of affordable home ownership housing at 385 Quincy Street and 409 Quincy Street with no cost to the Town; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that First Selectman William A. Gerber is authorized to execute all documents in connection thereto.”
