4. To receive a report from the Traffic Authority per Section 102-19 of the Town Code.

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5. To hear, consider and act upon the following resolution as recommended by the First Selectperson:

“WHEREAS, the Town of Fairfield has adopted an ordinance authorizing the use of automated traffic enforcement safety devices pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §14-307b et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Section 102-19 of the Town Code requires the Fairfield Traffic Authority to give a report to the Representative Town Meeting (RTM), including the data regarding the operation of the automated traffic enforcement safety devices in the Town of Fairfield; and

WHEREAS, the RTM has reviewed the Town of Fairfield Automated Traffic Enforcement Safety Device Plan (Plan), including the locations identified therein and data regarding the operation of the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the RTM hereby confirms the Plan and its continuation, as submitted to and approved by the Connecticut Department of Transportation.”
