- 2. To consider and act upon the Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on September 23, 2024.
- 3. To hear, consider and act upon the following appointment to the Employees Retirement Board as recommended by the First Selectman:

Caroline R. Crisa (D), 521 Riverside Drive, Nov. 2023 - 2028 (To fill a vacancy created by the resignation of Carolyn Trabuco)

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4. To hear, consider and act upon the following resolution as recommended by the Board of Finance:

"RESOLVED, that the First Selectman of the Town of Fairfield is empowered to execute, authorize, and approve on behalf of the Town of Fairfield any and all contracts or amendments thereof with the Connecticut Region 1 Essential Support Function 8 (ESF8) Public Health Preparedness Grant fiduciary organization with regard to the CDC 2024-2029 Public Health Emergency Preparedness Cooperative Agreement, with a grant funding period of July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2029. (Funding shall be for \$34,043 per year for each of 5 years, or as amended by the CDC, State of CT, or the Region 1 ESF 8 Public Health Preparedness Grant fiduciary organization and shall cover the cost to support Fairfield's continued public health emergency preparedness and response efforts. All costs are 100% reimbursable from the CDC 2024-2029 PHEP Cooperative Agreement via the State of CT and the CT Region 1 ESF8 Fiduciary Organization)."

- 5. To consider and act upon an ordinance establishing a Flood Prevention, Climate Resilience and Erosion Control Board, sponsored by Peter Britton, District 1; Liz Zezima, District 4; and Sharon Pistilli, District 5.
- 6. The Moderator has referred an Ordinance on Traffic Authority to the Legislation and Administration Committee under Rule 32 of the RTM Rules to Regulate.
- 7. The Moderator has referred amendments to the Tax Relief for the Elderly and Disabled Homeowners Ordinance, Section 95-7 to Section 97-15.4 of Chapter 95, Article III, of the Code of the Town of Fairfield, sponsored by the Senior & Disabled Tax Relief Committee, to the Legislation and Administration Committee under Rule 32 of the RTM Rules to Regulate.

The Moderator has referred amendments to the Streets and Sidewalk Ordinance, Section 91-2 of the Code of the Town of Fairfield, sponsored by Myke Hartigan, District 3; Chris Carroll, District 8; and Mark McDermott, District 9, to the Legislation and Administration Committee under Rule 32 of the RTM Rules to Regulate.
