

SEWER CONSTRUCTION ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE SANITARY DISTRICT OF ELGIN, KANE AND COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No sewer to be installed for the purpose of discharging sewage for treatment by the SANITARY DISTRICT OF ELGIN shall be constructed without first obtaining a written construction permit from the DISTRICT.

2. No discharge of sewage from a sewer line shall be permitted without a second written permit from the DISTRICT indicating that the sewer has been installed in compliance with this Ordinance. Any sewer not constructed in accordance with this Ordinance shall not be allowed to discharge sewage for treatment by the DISTRICT.

3. All sewers, including trunk line sewers and lateral sewers, that will discharge sewage for treatment by the SANITARY DISTRICT OF ELGIN, shall be installed under the supervision of a full time resident engineer. No work shall be done in the absence of the resident engineer.

4. The DISTRICT shall have the right to approve the selection of a resident engineer. The DISTRICT shall have the right to request a substitute resident engineer in the event of unsatisfactory performance by the resident engineer.

5. The resident engineer on any sewer construction project shall provide the DISTRICT with written reports not less than every two weeks.

6. All new sanitary sewers shall be pressure tested to the procedure outlined in the "Specifications for Low Pressure Air Tests of Sanitary Sewers" available at the SANITARY DISTRICT OF ELGIN office. The DISTRICT may require such other tests as conditions may require.

7. The cost of providing resident engineering and pressure testing shall be borne by the owner or developer and the specifications and costs shall be included in all bid proposals.
