- 4. Written test on Saturday March 30, 2024 at the Granite City Campus of SWIC College This is a general aptitude type test. You must achieve a passing score in order to proceed.
- 5. Interview with the Board of Police Commissioners. Candidates are evaluated based on their ability to communicate, judgment, and social skills to name a few. You must achieve a passing score in order to proceed.
- 6. A hiring eligibility list is established, which is valid for 2 years or until the list is exhausted. Ranking is based on written test score (up to 45 points), interview (up to 45 points), level of education (4 -10 points), and a bonus for military veterans (5 points). Candidates are ranked in order of their overall score.
- 7. Probationary starting at \$50,953. Second year increases substantially, \$71,078 \$73,048 depending on college degree level incentives.
- 8. 100% paid health insurance for employee and immediate family.
- 9. 11 paid holidays and shift differential pay.
- 10. College tuition paid for advanced degree.
- 11. Can live anywhere in Madison County, IL and includes any other cities or county that borders Madison County, including those in Missouri.
