ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the Village of Greenville, 2024 Paving Projects, Contract A-24, will be accepted through Quest vBid electronic bid service, *or* by submitting a paper copy at the Village Hall, W6860 Parkview Drive, Greenville, WI 54942, by 11:00 AM (local time) on April 25, 2024; and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The work, in general, will include the approximate quantities and items listed below:

76,500 SY – Pulverize Existing Asphalt Pavement,
76,700 SY – Hot Mix Asphalt Pavement,
51,200 LF – Crushed Aggregate Base Shoulder,
930 LF – 30” Mountable Curb and Gutter,
Pavement Marking,
Traffic Control, and
Landscape Restoration.

The proposals shall be submitted on the forms furnished with the specifications. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check payable to the owner equal to five percent (5%) of the proposal or a bid bond of a bonding company duly authorized to do business in the State of Wisconsin in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the proposal. This proposal guarantee shall be subject to forfeiture as provided by law. When submitting an electronic bid, Bidder is required to deliver the original certified check or bid bond within 72 hours of bid opening to Cedar Corporation.

For this project, bids will be received and accepted via the online electronic bid service through QuestCDN vBid online bidding, or by sealed paper copy. Proposals shall not be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the date of opening. The Village of Greenville reserves the right to reject any or all of the proposals and to waive any informalities therein.
