Wisconsin State Statues and the Village of Greenville Ordinances require all dogs five (5) months of age to be vaccinated for rabies and licensed. License are valid as of January 1, expire December 31 of each year, and are to be purchased on an annual basis.

Requirements: You are required by the State to include a copy of the rabies vaccination certificate when you are applying for a license. The rabies vaccination certificate from your veterinarian should show the given date the expiration date and the rabies tag number.
