RE: **2040 Comprehensive Plan Annual Report Year 2 (2021)**

ACTION TYPE: This item is for Discussion.

BACKGROUND & SUMMARY: In July 2019 Greenville adopted its [2040 Comprehensive Plan](#) and immediately started implementation. The plan outlines general timeframes to accomplish the Action Items. These timeframes are guides and are to be fluid and flexible and will and should change based on priorities set by the Planning Commission and Board. Additionally, the [Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan](#) was adopted at the same time as the 2040 Comprehensive Plan with its action item status identified in this report.

In addition to the 2040 Comprehensive Plan effort, in 2020 the Village underwent a planning process to focus its efforts on specific areas in the community. As a result the [2020 Sub-Area Plan](#) was developed and adopted as part of the Comprehensive Plan, focusing on the Heritage District (TID 2), the East Industrial Park Area (TID 1), the Sports + Splash and Lions Park Area and Gateways/Corridors with its action item status identified in this report.

The following Action Items status terms are defined as follows for the tables below:

1. **Not Started** means the Action Item has not been started.
2. **In Progress** means the Action Item has been started but not finished.
3. **Completed** means the Action Item has been completed.
4. **Ongoing** means the Action Item may have a status of not started, completed or in progress. Not every ongoing Action Item will necessarily be acted on each year or be able to be marked as completed and may be marked as completed in multiple years depending on the action item, they may be in a continual status of in progress as well.

Greenville has been very successful in implementing its plan with an 87% completion rate for the 1-2 year timeframe and a 28% completion rate for the 2-5 year timeframe; completion rates increased 8% and 20% respectively. Even the action items identified as ongoing has a completion rate of 43%, a slight uptick from the previous year. As indicated above, the ongoing category will fluctuate from year to year due to the nature of the action items.

There is one action item that was not started in the 1-2 year timeframe which was 9e-1: Create a new Historic Preservation Committee. This was discussed early on after plan adoption with the Land Stewardship Committee to see if it would consider taking on this task and the Committee declined as its focus was on farmland preservation. It is likely this project will only be initiated through a grass roots effort and may take some time before it is tackled.

In addition to the 7 projects that are currently in progress, the following projects/action items are planned to be undertaken in 2022:

1. Action Item 4c-2: Prepare Area Development Plans for sub-areas A-F. With the anticipated growth and the recently completed water and sanitary sewer studies, additional planning is important to be proactive and ready for when development knocks on Greenville's door.
2. Action Items 8a-5 & 8a-7 related to updating the 2008 Community Management Capacity Study to serve as a guide for staffing levels to maintain services during the planning period and evaluate alternatives and costs for the expansion/renovation of the Village Hall. The Village Board directed Administration to conduct a staffing study to determine the needs of the Village Hall.
3. 2020 Sub-Area Plan Recommendation #1 of page 27: Develop a strategy for assembling properties within targeted redevelopment areas of the 2020 Sub-Area Plan/TID 2. Now that Tax Increment District #2 has been created, it will be important to focus on development opportunities in this area.
