Grundy County Recorder Warns of DD214 Service

MORRIS, IL - Grundy County Clerk & Recorder Kay Olson, is warning local veterans of a company who is offering to submit military discharge papers (DD214), on behalf of the veteran, to be recorded and or to provide copies of the DD214, for a hefty fee. DD214 Direct, is a company out of Phoenix, AZ, who charges veterans a fee of \$79 and above for a service that is free to all veterans.

Olson would like to remind the public that these services are provided to veterans at no cost in the Grundy County Recorder's Office. Any veteran wishing to record their military discharge papers may do so by simply bringing their DD214 in person, or may mail them to the office. The DD214 will be recorded and the veteran will be provided copies free of charge.
