I. Approval of Council Minutes from February 23, 2022.

A motion was made by Ginger Gunn to approve the minutes; motion was seconded and passed March 16, 2022.

II. Financial Report

Sheryl reported that the \$20,000 from Holladay City has been added to the budget. The ZAP grant is due at the end of April for \$15,000 and Sheryl will be working on that. Sheryl is still waiting to hear from Holladay Bank & Trust as our main sponsor. Sheryl will be sending out letters to people who in the past have been sponsors. The 2022 -2023 budget is coming together and the spending for the fiscal year is on track.

III. Executive Director Report

Sheryl reported that at our last meeting in February, the mayor was here and asked if it was possible to remove the west pillar of the gazebo, and the answer is no. This question was brought up to help the sight line. However, progress is being made for the electrical problem we have with the gazebo. We're trying to get another electrical box put in.

Sheryl is working on the public sculpture RFQ with Jim Glenn from the Utah Division of Arts and Museums. Two names were drawn by Paul Fotheringham for the sculpture committee. The two who will serve on the committee are Bonnie Nell and Chris Knaphus.

Creative Aging deadline for signups is this Sunday. The classes will begin April 4th, 10:00-12:00 every Monday and Wednesday in April. The work created at this workshop will be shown as the "May Artist of the Month".

IV Event Updates

a. Dance Concert

Ginger reported the Dance Concert will be April 11th at 7:00 at Olympus Junior High. Volunteers from the council will help with directing people and handing out programs. Hank Kesler and Kathy Murphy will be taking photos of the dance concert.

Advertising for the Dance Concert will be in the Journal April 6th or 7th. An email will be sent out soon also advertising the event.

Beckie is designing the program.

b. Children's Theatre

Natalie reported that plans for the Children's Theatre are going well. There will be 30 kids involved, 1st grade through 6th. Due to the response, there will be a waiting list available.

c. Fine Art Show

Sheryl reported all the painting for the Fine Art Show has been hung and they look great. The judges have already come through and made their choices.

The method for judging used this year was that the judges distributed post-it notes on the art they thought worthy of prizes and then they compared each other's choices and selected the winners.

Every year people ask about the judges and their process.

There were about 150 artists in this year's Fine Art Show.

The reception will be on Saturday March 19th from 6:00-8:00. There will be simple food and music. Natalie will bring extra chocolates. The food crew should plan on being there from 5:00-8:00 and enter from the south door of the Big Cottonwood room. Sheryl will monitor the "People's Choice" award.

Beckie & Sheryl will be putting up labels tomorrow.

The entertainment will be Gary Hansen, a professional Native American flute player, and two string quartets from the Sotto Voce School of Music.

Art pick up will Friday March 25th and Monday March 28th.

d. Blue Moon Logo

e. Blue Moon Festival
