FINANCIAL REPORT - Sheryl

We are in good financial shape, still short on revenue, but also still expecting more to come in before June 30.

SCULPTURE UPDATE - Sheryl and Paul Fotheringham

The City Council was recently updated on our new plaza sculpture with unanimous approval. There was discussion about uplifting the trees at night as well! The recent community survey was again mentioned with 70% approval ratings, concerts & events being the most popular and receiving the highest approval ratings.

TINY ARTS UPDATE - Becky Rock

Just completed with huge success. 113 artists participated, 68 of which sold artwork. 412 submissions (321 last year). \$11,132. Sold (10,000 last year). Using the 'Square' for purchases works great (except for the first day snag). All the hanging hardware we have was used for this year. Even had \$160.00 in donations. Sheryl reminded us to 'ask for donations' when staffing the sales table to help support our fabulous events. Many young

participants this year as well! The Journal did not come out until the end of the show so some people did not know about the event until late Friday. Discussion around getting it published well before the show next year for better attendance.
