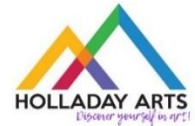

MANAGERS REPORT: (*Megan Attermann, Arts & Culture Manager*)

- Financial Report: July 1 through March 2024. Was tolined by Megan, with the note that it was in development with more information to follow.
- A Fine Art Show Reflection was presented with many of the Council members in agreement with the fine tuning of certain aspects to make the 2025 art show even better.
- 2023 Video Recap: the council viewed the video that was produced by Beckie Rock.
- Megan presented the results of the Fine Art Show including: 228 artists, 369 pieces, 1,134 attendees (this number was 761 last year), over \$11,8312.31 in sales, and over **200** hours of volunteer service.
- The Dance Concert had 650 in attendance, 150 youth, 10 volunteers, and 138 performing artists.
- Summer Concerts Update: Volunteer assignments were reviewed, and acts confirmed.
- Blue Moon Festival Volunteer Assignment sheets were sent around the group for sign up.

UPDATES:

- The Utility Box Program was brought up by Ilene Stowe, based on community input that we should consider expanding the program out to include more, high visibility locations.
- Beckie Rock updated the Council on the Kathy Murphy Historic Holladay Invitational
- Megan provided an update on the Creative Aging Workshop.
