FINANCIAL REPORT and Executive Director Updates – Sheryl

We are getting closer to balanced budget which will be probably be the end of June. Holladay Bank & Trust has sold which may end their sponsorship of our annual summer concert series. Both Sheryl and The Mayor are reaching out to bank leadership. Holladay City is updating its website, not sure the exact date. HAC will still look like our own site but be incorporated into the City site. Sheryl is meeting with the designer next week. Beckie has completed the 2022 year in review video for the website, if you haven't seen it! The Division of Arts & Museum Grant was submitted last week. The Legislature cut the additional funding request during the last part of the session, and also cut the regular arts budget by \$2M. While we asked for additional funds this year, we probably won't get them for this reason.
