bridge

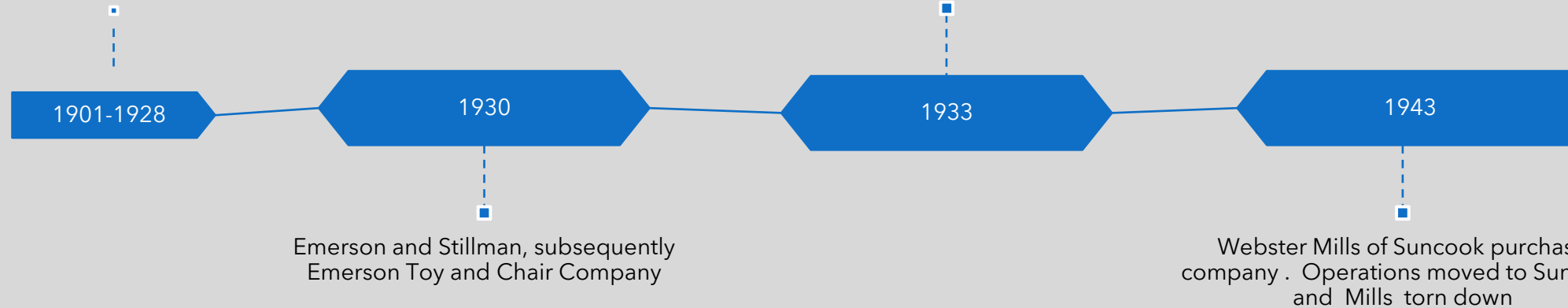

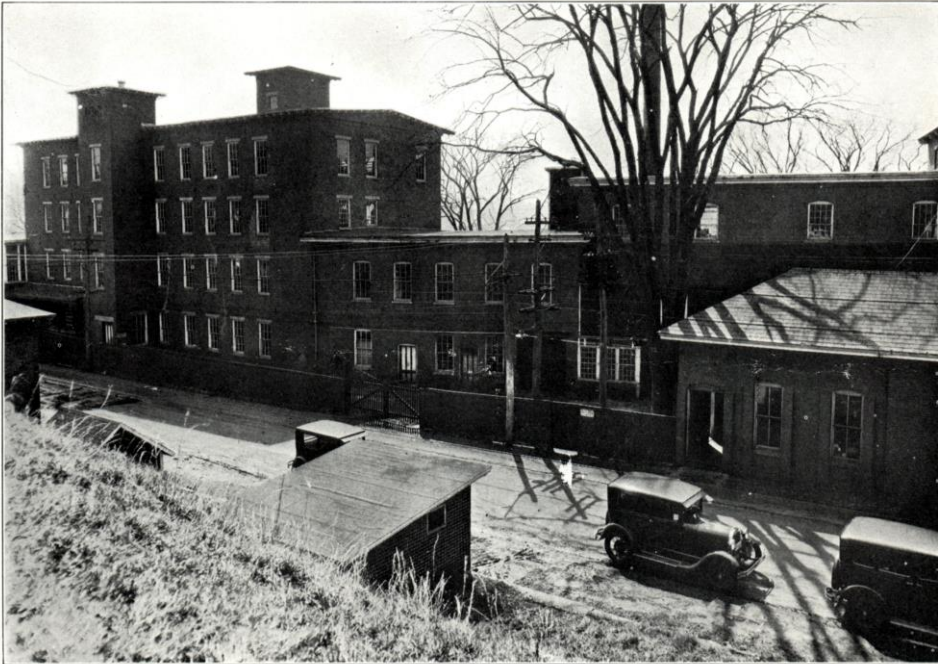

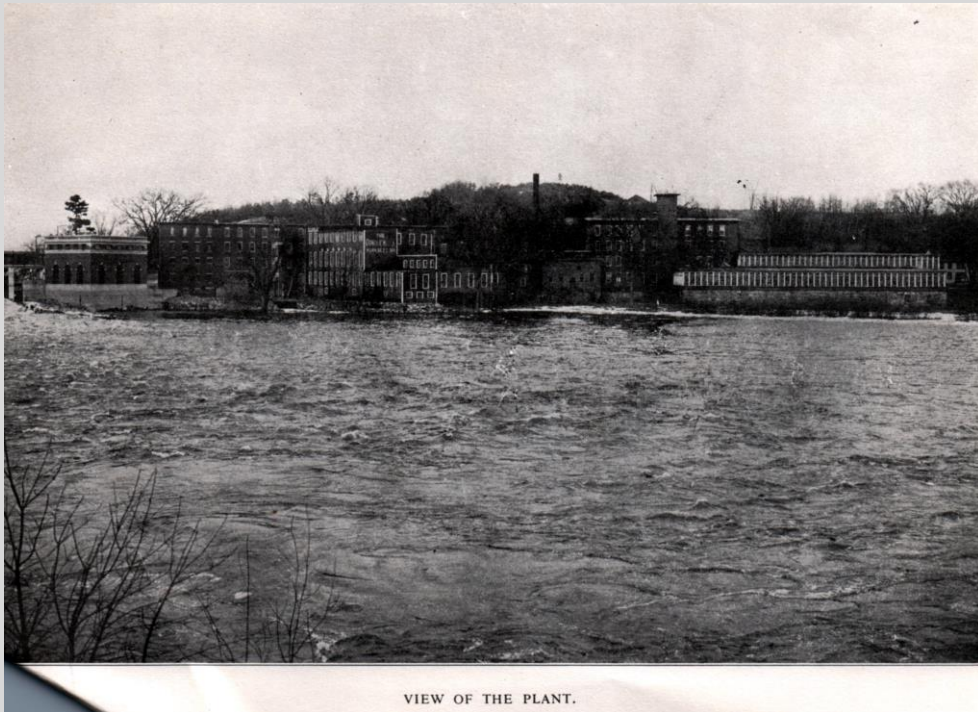

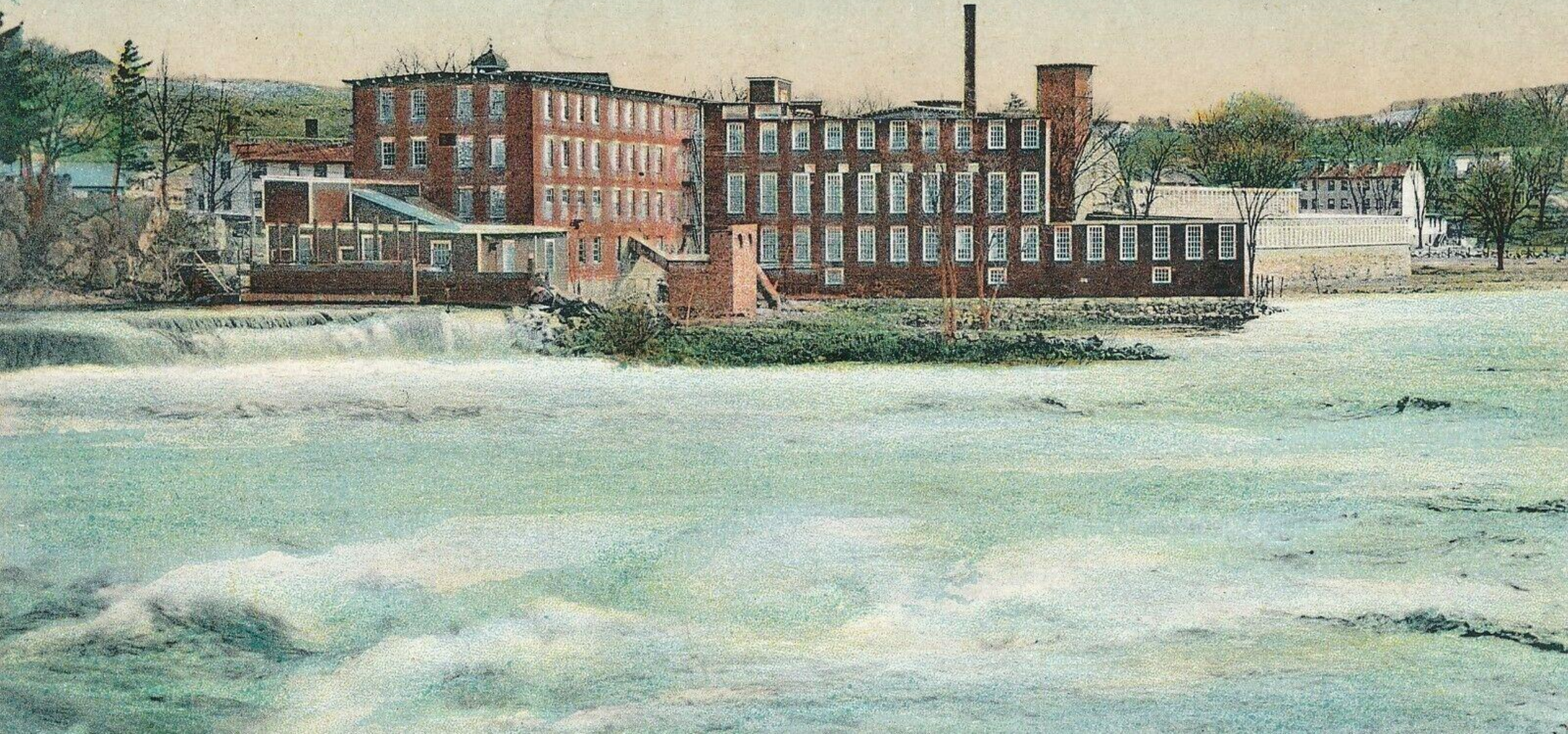

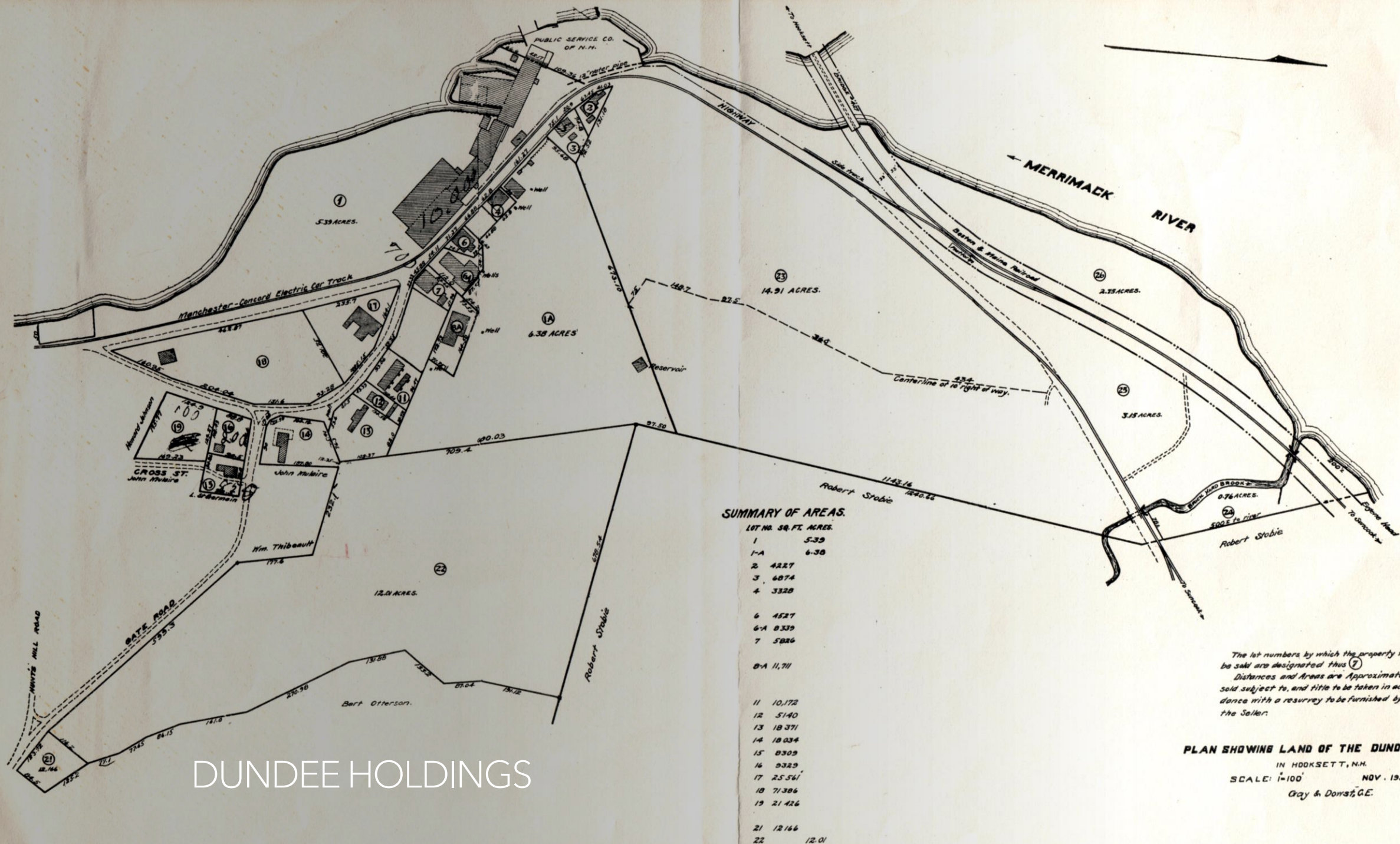

IN HOOKSETT, N.H.

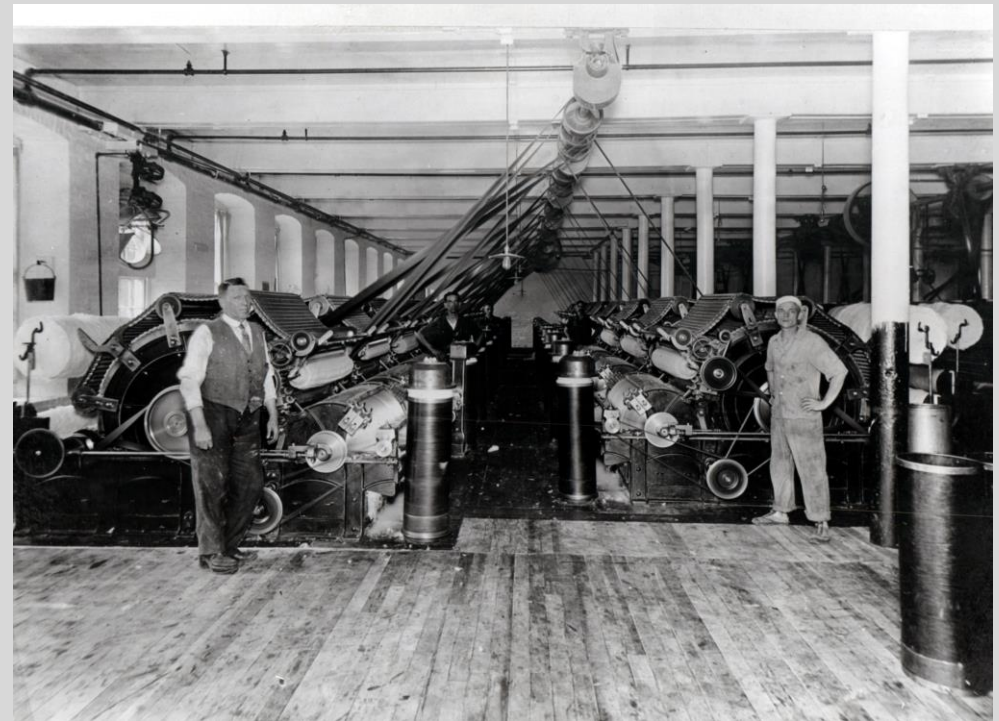
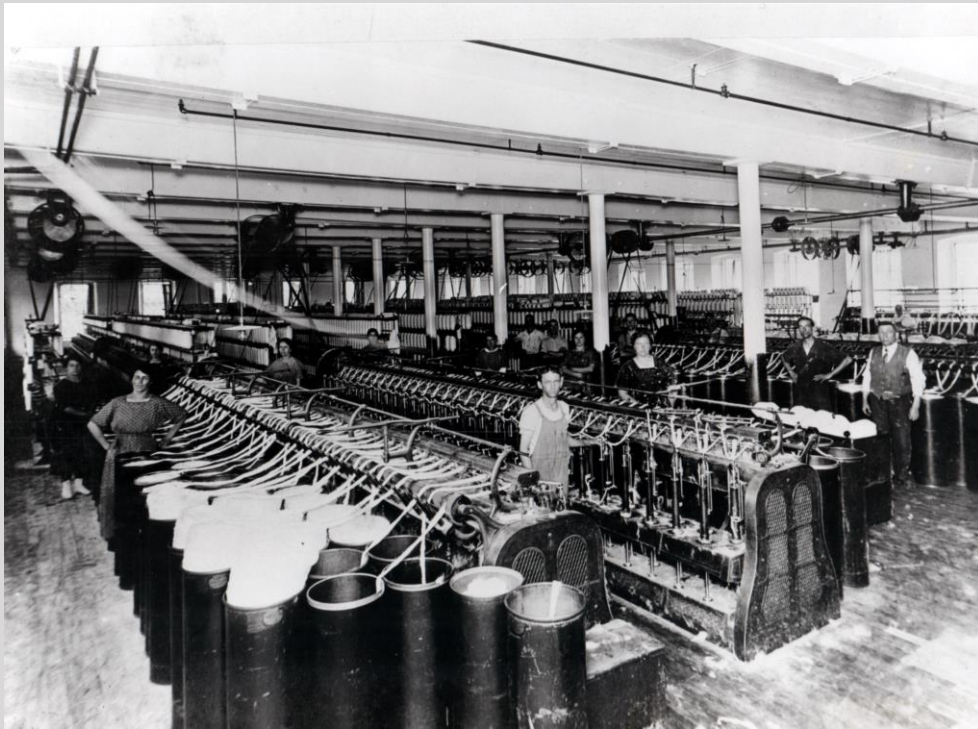
