## CASUALTY

---

During his service in the Vietnam War, Marine Corps Corporal Fraser experienced a traumatic event which ultimately resulted in loss of life on **December 28, 1967**. Recorded circumstances attributed to: **Died through hostile action, small arms fire.** Incident location: **South Vietnam, Quang Nam province.**



## DETAILS

---

On December 28, the command group, Company I, 3d Battalion, 5th Marines and attached Company E 2d Battalion, 3d Marines departed on Operation AUBURN. The Marines landed on Go Noi Island in the vicinity of Ky Lam Tay (1) and immediately began taking fire from the enemy. The fire fights would last throughout the day and into the next with numerous casualties, one of the men that was killed in action was Corp Fraser, attached with his scout dog he was killed by a sniper.





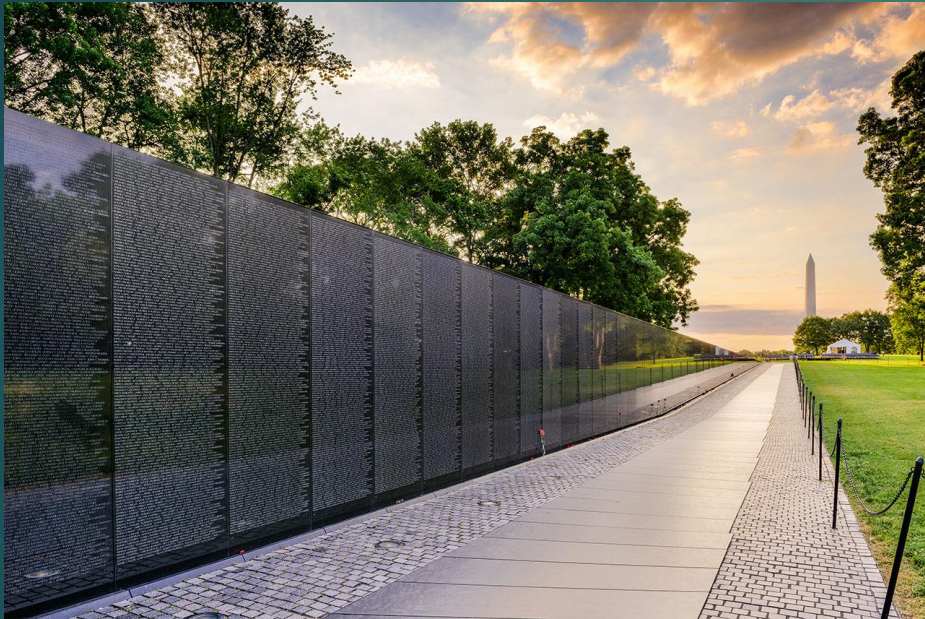
