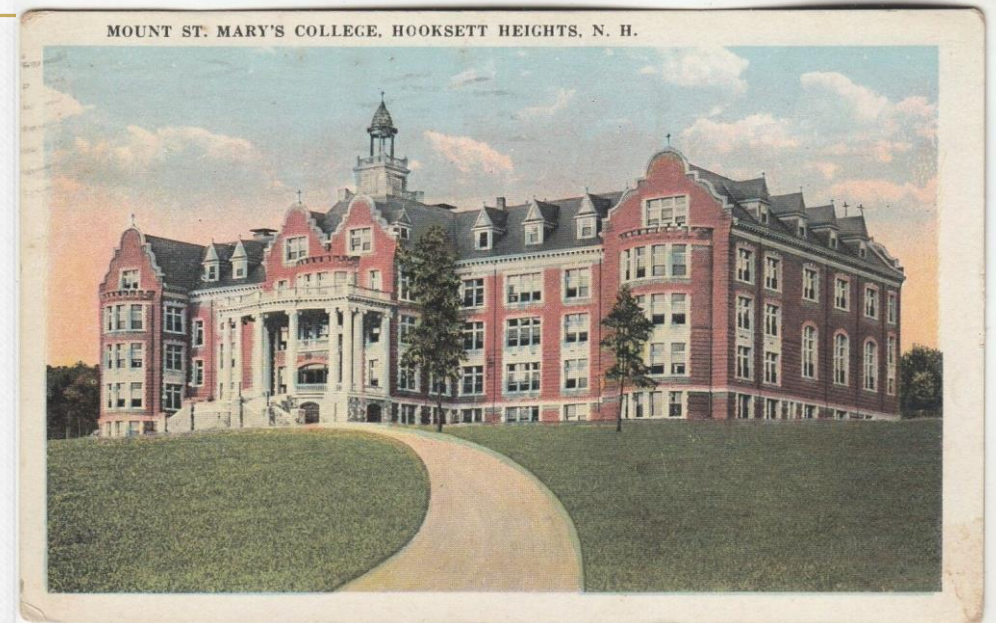


- 300 Acres

- Mercy Hall (1960's), McAuley Library, three -winged resident Hall, Gault Mansion

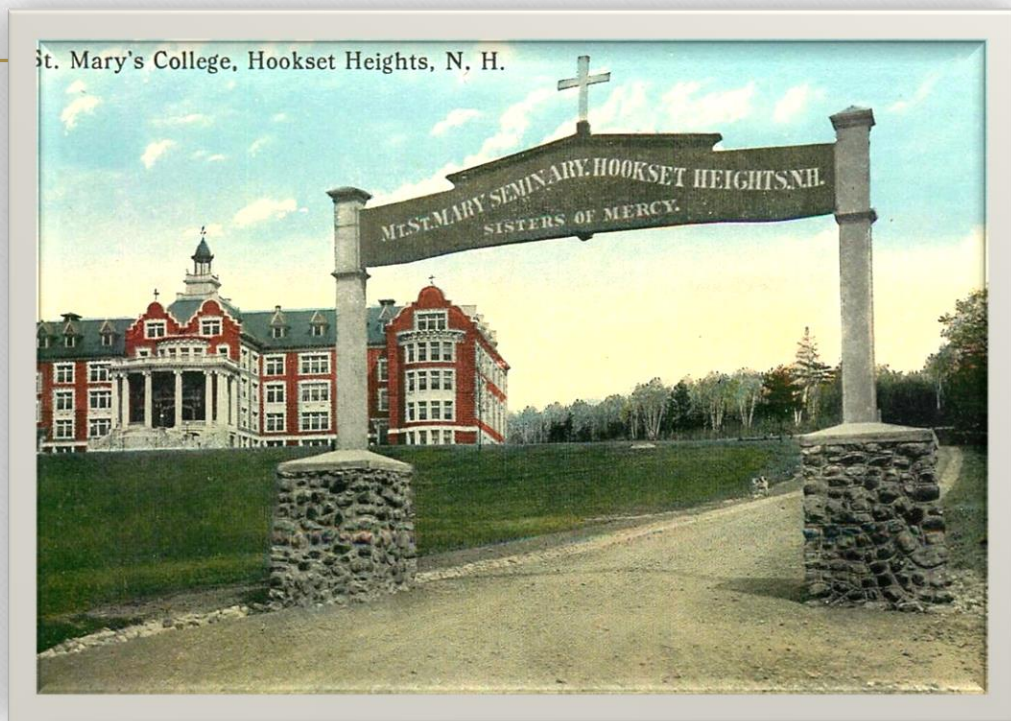
