

**BOARD OF ELECTION AND VOTING MEETING
THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2022, COUNCIL CHAMBERS**

Moderator Lizotte called meeting to order at 6:04pm.

Old Business:

Minutes of December 1, 2020, meeting. Supervisor Barb motioned to approve, Second by Supervisor Burkhart. All in favor. Moderator Lizotte abstained.

Supervisor Burkhart requested mention be made of his name change from Javier Olivarez to Stephen Burkhart. Item included for the record.

Noted that Mike Horne is uncontested on the ballot for March 8, 2022, election for Supervisor of the Checklist.

Supervisor Brennan reported that Supervisors are cleaning up old voter registration cards and still working on some 2020 election items.

Moderator Lizotte inquired about Hooksett redistricting, as mentioned in previous BOE minutes. Discussion ensued regarding Charter, Charter changes, districts for Council representation and the origins of districts for Council representation.

Moderator Lizotte requested an overview of general timeline and procedure for elections. Clerk Rainier responded with an overview of the process as it has been during his time as Clerk.

Supervisor Brennan stated she and Supervisor Burkhart are going to Pinkerton Academy on Tuesday, February 22, to register eligible Hooksett students to vote. Event is from 10:45am to 12:45pm.

Supervisor Brennan reminded the group the final Supervisors of the Checklist meeting before municipal election day is Saturday, February 26, 2022, at 10:00am in council chambers. This event will be the final opportunity before March 8 election day for qualified residents to register to vote. Qualified residents may register to vote at the March 8 election.

Supervisor Burkhart motioned and Moderator Lizotte second to adjourn at 7:05pm. Group voted unanimously to adjourn.
