TOWN ARTICLES CONTINUED To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$2,500,000.00) for the purpose of sewer and other infrastructure improvements on Route 3A in the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) District established in March of 2017, and to authorize the issuance of not more than Two Million Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$2,500,000.00) of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act, (RSA 33), as amended; and to authorize the Town Council to issue, negotiate, sell, and deliver such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon and maturity and other terms thereof; and to authorize the Town Council to apply for, obtain, and accept federal, state, or other aid, if any, which may be available for said project, and to comply with all laws applicable to said project; and to authorize the Town Council to take any other action, or pass any other vote, relative thereto; furthermore, to raise and 599 YES O appropriate the sum of Sixty-four Thousand dollars (\$64,000.00) from the Tax Increment Finance District Fund for the bond issuance costs and the first year's debt service payments on such bonds or notes. Bonds will be paid off in whole or in part from TIF District Funds.
