**Cemetery Commission Meeting

Re: Betty Hoadley (Head Cemetery) – the family has still not resolved who will be buried in the four cremation spots. We're awaiting her response. Her brother, Roger Kilgore, passed away. His family is working with Betty to determine where Roger and his wife will be buried in Head Cemetery.

New Business:

We can tell funeral homes that the cemeteries are open for burial in 2018.

Mike got reelected for a 3-year trustee term for May 1, 2018, to April 30, 2021. He will update the website.
