26 **CLAY CEMETARY**

27 Jordan Davis reviewed his work on the Clay Cemetery. Manchester Water Works has approved of work
28 to be done at the cemetery and will donate tools and resources to the cause. The owners of Steven Clay
29 Bed and Breakfast are willing to assist as well. Jordan is currently worked with the Town of Chester to
30 research their archives for information. A notice of work had to be posted 90 days prior to work
31 beginning to give any descendants a chance to come forward. That notice was posted in the Union
32 Leader on February 4, 2022. Currently, Jordan has the Grand Army of Republic Flag. A sign will be
33 installed but not until it is confirmed who is buried in that cemetery.

36 Jordan Davis was also assigned to assist in the restoration of the additional Cheever painting. It is in
