OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors discussed challenges they had scanning the Checklists of the Nov 8<sup>th</sup> General Election and how marks by the ballot clerks were very inconsistent and the worst they recall ever seeing. They will work with the Town Clerk and Moderator to ensure better training is conducted before elections and that more periodic checks are made at the polls to ensure ballot clerks are marking Checklists as required.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Approved removing 221 voters who moved out of Hooksett to other NH cities/towns
- Approved removing 9 voters due to death
- Approved sending 30-Day letters to 13 voters. Barb will print and mail them
- Ran an updated voter alpha checklist after the above changes were made  
Total voters: 9,733 Democrat: 2,681 Republican: 3,574 Undeclared 3,478
- Mike will recommend a meeting for the Board of Election Officers to meet to review Nov 8<sup>th</sup> election
- Mike will compose and mail a letter to voter 300483726 for clarification of note written on Checklist

Mike will make the Checklist certification and get it and the updated alpha voter list posted in the Clerk's office and at the Library on December 14th.
