**A RESOLUTION CELEBRATING THE 30<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY  
OF THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) was passed on July 26, 1990 to ensure the civil rights of citizens with disabilities; and

**NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED** that the City of Hudson does hereby declare July 26, 2020 as Americans with Disabilities Act Awareness Day and extends greetings and best wishes to all observing the historic recognition of the civil rights for persons with disabilities.
