**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE CLIMATE ADAPTIVE DESIGN PHASE II FINAL  
PRELIMINARY DESIGN REPORT FOR THE CITY OF HUDSON RIVERFRONT  
PARK**

**WHEREAS**, the Hudson Valley Collaborative has been engaged in a study and design process for the climate resiliency of the Henry Hudson Riverfront Park with support from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Hudson River Estuary Program and NEIWPC; and

**WHEREAS**, representatives from the City of Hudson worked with Hudson Valley Collaborative since October 2021 to collect local data; coordinate public outreach events, facilitate connection with stakeholders within the community, local organizations, and governmental agencies; review draft designs; and advise generally on the development of a long-term plan for adaptations to the Henry Hudson Riverfront Park to address changes to the park landscape due to imminent sea level rise; and

**WHEREAS**, these efforts have resulted in the creation of a written Hudson Climate Adaptive Design Phase II Final Preliminary Design Report (“CaD FPDR”); and

**WHEREAS**, having reviewed and considered the CaD FPDR, the Common Council wishes to formally voice its support for the recommendations contained therein,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Common Council hereby accepts the Climate Adaptive Design Phase II Final Preliminary Design Report prepared by the Hudson Valley Collaborative as prepared for the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Hudson River Estuary Program and NEIWPC, [and adopts the recommendations contained therein as a framework to facilitate future improvements to the Henry Hudson Riverfront Park to extend the usefulness of the Park as a public recreational space.]
