Dear Foundation Members,

This year marks our 27<sup>th</sup> annual Hudson Flag Day Parade & Festival. As you are aware, due to COVID, our 25<sup>th</sup> year celebration in 2020 was canceled. Last year we held the parade and festival, but on a smaller scale. It is our hope that this year we will be able to resume our activities as we had in the past; and we have set June 11 as the date of the event.

In past years, the Flag Day Parade provided a county wide celebration of patriotism and has been supported by approximately 100 marching units from Columbia and surrounding counties. It is estimated that we garnered some 10,000 spectators between the parade and waterfront festivities, which included spectacular fireworks that closed the event.

The Hudson Flag Day Parade committee is dedicated to providing a patriotic day to remember those who served their country and to honor the American Flag, as well as provide family-oriented activities for the entire county that residents and tourists have come to look forward to

In an effort to continue this valued community celebration, the Committee has incorporated into what is now **Hudson Flag Day Parade**, **Inc.** and has been classified as a public charity under IRC Section 501(c) (3) and additionally have been granted tax exempt status from the Internal Revenue Service. Donors are now able to deduct contributions made to Hudson Flag Day Parade, Inc. under IRC Section 170.

The Hudson Flag Day Parade, Inc. committee is comprised of dedicated volunteers who represent many different facets of our unique community; we are not associated with any organization. The committee meets on a continual basis throughout the year. The planning for this event is no small undertaking and requires much time, effort and most importantly - funding.

The parade committee is submitting this formal request for funding from the City of Hudson Common Council Tourism Committee in the amount of \$5,000. The funds we are requesting will be used directly in the programming of this highly anticipated summer event. These funds will be used for all community activities and programming (including fireworks, marching bands and other musical entertainment) which are an integral part of the Flag Day Program and Parade. They are an appropriate and much appreciated part of this day of honoring veterans and our flag. The community benefits from this event as it is a free, fun-filled activity for the entire family.

We have included here a description of our purpose, mission, budget showing our financial history, our 501(c)3 determination letter, our current officers and directors, and a listing of other groups and foundations that have supported us. Please let us know if you need any additional information.

If we are approved for a grant the check should be made payable to **Hudson Flag Day Parade, Inc.** (Tax Identification number: 47-2730955) and mailed to our address as listed above. Upon receipt we will provide the City of Hudson Common Council Tourism Committee with a tax receipt and acknowledgment letter.

We thank you and would like you to know how much we appreciate your consideration, as it is through the generosity of patrons such as yourselves that we are able to continue this annual event.
