

Please support Dalmatian Day September 24, 2022

Dalmatian Day attracts 2,000+ visitors to the Museum for this one day event. The event was paused due to Covid-19, and we would now like to restart this event. Our data from past events showed that this event attracted a large number of visitors from the surrounding counties. In particular, we attracted many visitors from Greene and Dutchess counties, as well as NYC. These visitors will shop and purchase other consumables before and after the event, which will benefit the City of Hudson. This event had become an annual event for many families and they are very excited to see it restarted.

In addition to this event supporting tourism efforts in Hudson, it also will keep our community safer. This is largest one day fire safety event in New York State. Children in the United States cause over 67,500 fires each year alone. Children cause nearly 230 fire deaths, 1,800 fire injuries and \$235 million dollars in direct property damage each year. In 85% of these cases, children themselves are the victims. It is estimated that for every one child-caused fire we know of, at least ten more have occurred. This is because so many fires are not reported to fire departments out of shame and embarrassment. We believe teaching fire safety and prevention is crucial to the safety and well-being of the children in our community, and the US Fire Administration (USFA) agrees. This agency found that fire setting, which children often do out of curiosity, can be curtailed in a community by providing fire safety education for children throughout the year. Dalmatian Day helps to teach and re-enforce fire safety and prevention concepts, which in- turn will make our children and our community safer.
