The \$5,000 funding request will support three significant events in Hudson, NY: Beautiful Racket's 3rd annual summer festival, and both the summer and winter Hudson Community Choir performances. The festival, scheduled for July 28, 2024, celebrates the diverse talent and creativity of Hudson's local artists, performers, and vendors, attracting an estimated 200 attendees. Additionally, the Hudson Community Choir Friends and Family Performance at Hudson Hall on June 6th will feature 50 choir members and draw 150 attendees. The winter choir performance, scheduled for December 2024, will also showcase local talent and draw a similar audience size. These events serve as vital platforms for showcasing local talent, fostering cultural exchange, and promoting community engagement. In total, these performances will bring in at least 550 attendees, with 120 performers from Hudson and around.

The requested funding of \$5,000 will be utilized as follows:

For the 3rd Annual Beautiful Racket Summer Festival:

\$3,000 will be allocated for performance payments, including \$800 for the headliner, \$400 for the main act, and \$800 for the rest of the student performers (\$100 each).

\$1,000 will be used for signage, including banners to be placed over entrance ways into Hudson and stage signage.

For the other two performances (summer and winter):

\$2,000 will be allocated, with \$500 for the accompanist (\$250 for each performance) and \$800 for other musicians (band, 4 piece) (\$400 for each performance).

An additional \$700 will be designated for recruitment purposes, covering tabling and marketing items to recruit diverse community members at four more festivals (Bangladeshi Festival, Pride Festival, Sankofa Black Arts and Culture Festival, Latinx Festival). This includes the procurement of tabling materials, signs from staples, branded apparel for volunteers, informational materials, and stipends for food from other festival vendors for volunteers.

Overall, the funding will be utilized to ensure fair compensation for performers, enhance visibility through signage, and support recruitment efforts to engage a diverse audience. These investments will contribute to the success and impact of the summer festival and other performances, enriching the cultural
