Thank you for the work that you do for the City of Hudson. I'd like to voice my opinion to NOT support the Restore NY Grant for the Bliss Tower redevelopment on 2nd Street and across from Rope Alley.

I do not feel the proposed design is aligned with Hudson's character and goals. The building scale is too big. 300 units is far too many for this space. The proposed design destroys an existing park space to replace it with a dark courtyard and more Tower in a Park design; which has historically proven to be a disaster for public housing.

Supporting the need for affordable housing and this project are not mutually exclusive. I do not think THIS project should be approved and instead a smaller scale development.
