A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE USE OF 11 WARREN STREET FOR COUNTY OFFICES

WHEREAS, The Columbia County Board of Supervisors has acquired 11 Warren Street with the intention of moving four County offices into that location and of using some of the space for storage of election machines; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the acquisition and refurbishment to Columbia County taxpayers in the amount of \$8,750,000 with an approximate cost of \$477.00 per square foot; and

WHEREAS, this location is within the Downtown Revitalization district within the City of Hudson and the proposed use by the County is inconsistent with the City of Hudson's plans for that district which would include mixed use commercial and residential development; and

WHEREAS, mixed use development would generate property tax revenue and sales tax revenue for the county; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City Hudson opposes Columbia County's plan to locate County offices at 11 Warren Street in the City of Hudson.
