A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE NEW YORK STATE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY PASS LEGISLATION EXTENDING TAX LAW §1202-DD AND AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A HOME RULE NOTICE

WHEREAS, effective November 28, 2016, the New York State Senate and Assembly enacted enabling legislation authorizing a lodging tax in the City of Hudson pursuant to Tax Law §1202-dd ("Lodging Tax"); and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid authorization by the NYS legislature with regard to the Lodging Tax is set to expire December 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council believes it is in the best interest of the City that the Lodging Tax be extended by the NYS legislature;

WHEREAS, Senator Hinchey and Assemblywoman Barrett have drafted legislation that has been introduced in both the Senate (Senate Bill No. S8345) and the Assembly (Assembly Bill No. A8784) authorizing the aforesaid tax extension through December 2028;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City Hudson hereby formally authorizes a Home Rule Request for Senate Bill No. S8345 and Assembly Bill No. A8784 to extend Tax Law § 1202-DD and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby authorized to execute those documents necessary to submit a Home Rule Notice to the New York State Senate and Assembly seeking an extension of the Lodging Tax legislation for the City of Hudson by said legislative bodies.
