Dear Mayor Johnson, Treasurer Campbell:

Please accept this letter as submission in response to your request for proposal for legal services. Overview:

In addition to the fee for legal services, the City will reimburse the Firm for any reasonable actual expenses or disbursements incurred by the Firm on behalf of the City, including filing fees, recording fees, fees for searches, investigative expenses, fees for stenographic transcripts of testimony, travel and lodging expenses, long distance telephone charges, photocopying charges, expert witness fees and any other reasonable expense incurred by the Firm in performing the services to be provided under this agreement. If requested, the City will make payment directly to the provider of any such services. The firm will obtain your authorization for any one charge or expense that exceeds \$500.00.

The firm may assign responsibility for performance of services to be provided under this agreement to one or more attorneys, in accordance with the firm's professional judgment. Certain services may be performed by legal assistants or other staff under the supervision of an attorney.

The firm will send statements to the City monthly detailing services rendered and for expenditures which we have made on behalf of the City. Charges for legal fees and expenses are payable within 30 days after the date of the invoice. A finance charge of 1% per month will be charged on any account balance not paid within 30 days of billing.

Miscellaneous Matters

The Firm reserves the right to withdraw from this case whenever withdrawal is required or permitted by ethical standards of practice. In the event that the substitution of attorneys becomes necessary you will provide the necessary consent for substitution of attorneys of your choice and cooperate fully in effecting such substitution.
