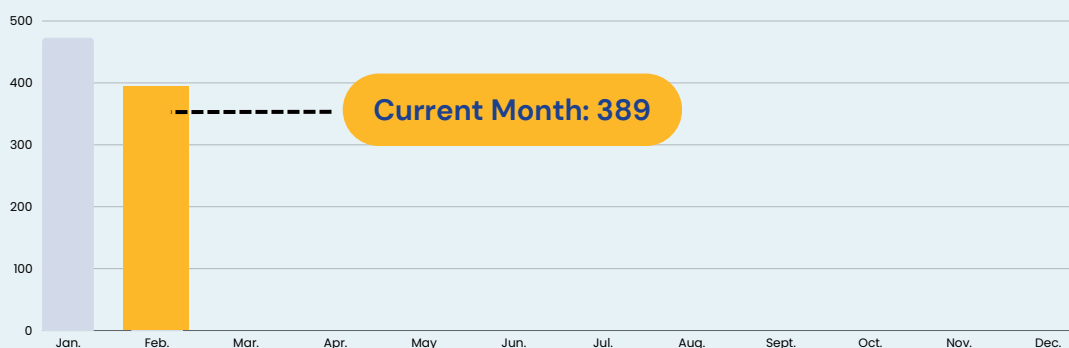




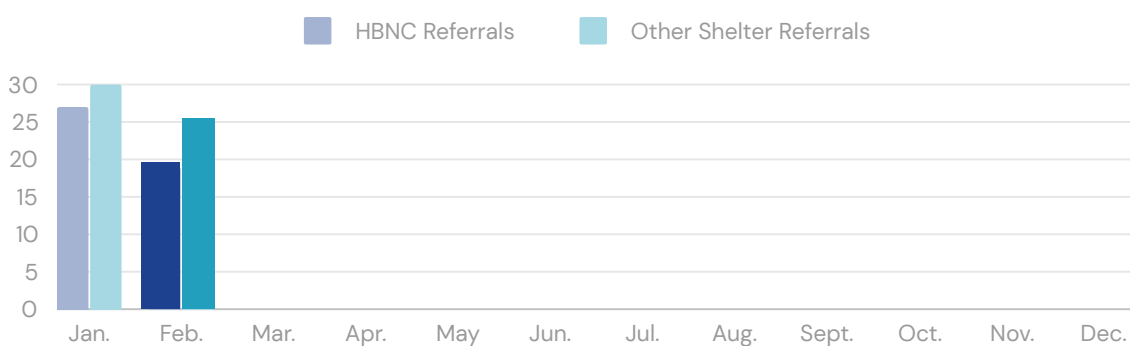

The City's Outreach Social Workers assist persons in need to qualify for a range of housing opportunities. Examples include emergency housing vouchers, rapid rehousing, permanent supportive housing, and family reunification. The successes shown are only representative of the City's Social Workers.

SUCCESS STORIES

County Shelter Referral



The male individual had been staying outside the Police Department with no where to go. Due to his lack of ties, our Social Workers were able to make a referral to Yale Navigation Center, a county shelter, where the individual can receive the services he needs. Our Social Worker also provided him with fleece poncho to keep him warm and coordinated transportation services.

Vital Documents



To qualify for services, individuals need to be "document ready", however many times individuals do not have all their vital documents in place and they need to go through the process to obtain them. On this occasion the individual needed to have a notarized letter in order to receive his birth certificate. Our Social Worker, who is certified to notarize documents, was able to assist the individual removing the barrier towards the path to housing.
