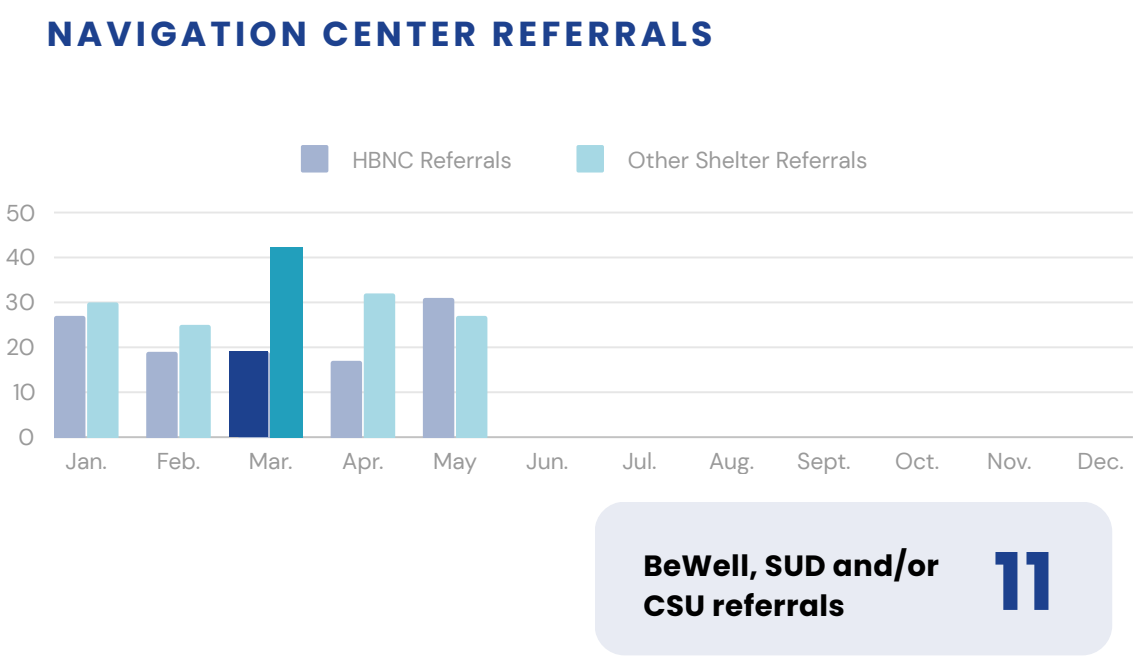
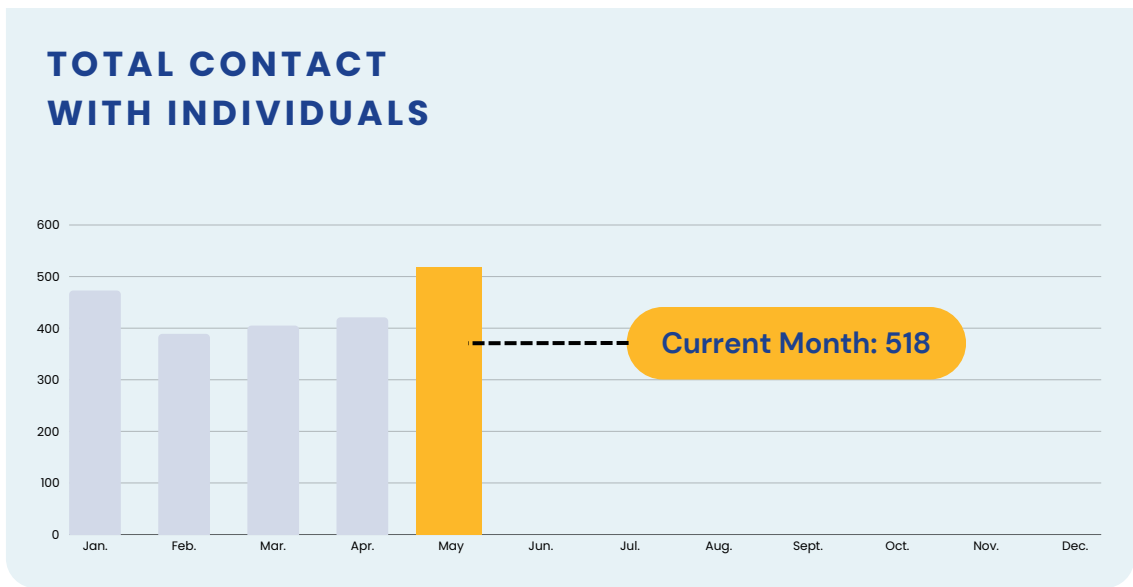




# Outreach Social Worker Team

The City's Outreach Social Workers assist persons in need to qualify for a range of housing opportunities. Examples include emergency housing vouchers, rapid rehousing, permanent supportive housing, and family reunification. The successes shown are only representative of the City's Social Workers.

### SUCCESS STORIES

#### Wound Care at Street Level

During a street outreach day, our Social Worker encountered an individual in need of wound care. Our Social Worker promptly contacted the Orange County Health Department to arrange for a Public Health Nurse. Given the severity of the wound, the Public Health Nurse called in a street medical team for additional assistance. As a result, the client received the necessary care, and our Social Worker can now continue working on a housing plan with the client.

#### System of Care Collaboration

After receiving information from the public about an individual who had been parked on the street for an extended period, our Social Worker checked on the person, who was in a wheelchair and immediately accepted services. The Social Worker coordinated with the Be Well Mobile Crisis Response team to transport the individual to the Navigation Center and collaborated with the Homeless Task Force Officers to remove the individual's car.

#### Matched to Housing

Social Worker met a Veteran client at Community United Methodist Church during offsite office hours. The Social Worker was able to make a referral to the Veterans Resource Center and soon after the client was matched to the Mesa Vista Permanent Supportive Housing project where he is now permanently housed.
