## Available Opportunities



Volunteer opportunities for teens ages 13 - 18 at the **Oak View Branch Library** include:

**Chess Club & Tabletop Saturdays' Helper**  
(age 14+)

Help out on **Saturdays** with **Tabletop Saturdays** and/or **Dragons and Dungeons** *between 12:30-4:30 pm, or with Chess Club from 2:30-4:30 pm.* You will be teaching participants how to play various board games. If you have any previous chess experience, you might be asked to assist teaching basic chess skills to new players.

**Fun with Lego Helper**  
(age 13+)

Fun with Lego meets on the second and fourth Friday of the month 3 pm to 4:30 pm. Your job will be to help set out, sort and clean up Legos for the program, supervise kids as they build and play, and help them out with their builds. You can also suggest fun building challenges for future sessions!

**General Library**  
(age 14+)

Assist library staff with cleaning books, preparing crafts, organizing supplies, assisting with programs and much more. This is an invaluable volunteer position as there are many small tasks to complete in the library. **Hours earned are variable, on an as-needed basis.**

**Homework Club Helper**  
(9th grade & up)

Help school age children (k-8th) with their homework assignments after school. Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays 2- 5:00 pm; and Wednesdays 12:30-4:30 pm. during school year (**September - June**). You will make a difference!

**Special Projects**  
(age 13+)

Occasionally the library has a particular special project it needs assistance with, such as organizing a craft closet or working at an all day event. Volunteers help with set-up, breakdown, helping patrons, replenishing supplies, etc. **Hours earned are variable, on an as-needed basis.**

**Volunteer Page**  
(age 14+)

Library pages straighten shelves, return books to their rightful places, and help library visitors locate items. You will need to pass a test of your alphabetizing and Dewey Decimal knowledge to be considered for this opportunity. **Hours earned are variable, on an as-needed basis.**
