Fatal Traffic Collision – Beach Boulevard and Adams Avenue

On Wednesday, September 22, 2021, at approximately 4:22 p.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department (HBPD) responded to a traffic collision on Beach Boulevard, north of Adams Avenue, involving a Harley Davidson motorcycle and a Toyota Rav-4.

Upon arrival, officers located the Harley Davidson driver, a 54-year old male from Stanton, deceased at the scene.

The driver of the RAV-4, a 90-year old male from Huntington Beach, sustained injuries and was transported to a local area hospital. It is unknown at this time whether drugs or alcohol were a factor in the collision.

Based on the preliminary investigation, circumstances suggest that the Harley Davidson was traveling northbound on Beach Boulevard, north of Adams Avenue, when it collided with the RAV-4 as it made a left turn across northbound lanes from the southbound Beach Boulevard left turn pocket.

The collision investigation is ongoing and being conducted by the HBPD Multidisciplinary Accident Investigation Team (MAIT).
