Fatal Traffic Collision – Bolsa Chica Street, North of Argosy Avenue

On Tuesday, May 31, 2022, at approximately 11:00 p.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department (HBPD) responded to a traffic collision on Bolsa Chica Street, north of Argosy Avenue, involving a pedestrian and a gray 2019 Toyota Highlander.

Upon arrival, officers located the pedestrian, a 63-year-old female, deceased in the roadway. The driver of the Highlander, a 60-year-old male, and a passenger, a 49-year-old female, both from Huntington Beach, remained at the scene and fully cooperated with officers. It does not appear that drugs or alcohol were a factor in the collision.

Based on the preliminary investigation, the Highlander was traveling southbound on Bolsa Chica Street and struck the pedestrian in the roadway, outside of the crosswalk, north of Argosy Avenue.

The collision investigation is ongoing and being handled by the HBPD Multidisciplinary Accident Investigation Team (MAIT). Anyone who may have witnessed the collision or the events leading up to it is encouraged to contact HBPD Traffic Investigator D. Demetre at (714) 536-5670.
