## Fatal Traffic Collision- Bushard Street and Atlanta Avenue

On Saturday, August 25, 2024, at approximately 3:00 p.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department (HBPD) responded to a traffic collision involving an electric bicycle on Bushard Street and Atlanta Avenue.

Upon arrival, officers located the rider of the electric bicycle, a 56-year-old male from Huntington Beach, with life-threatening injuries. The rider of the electric bicycle was transported to a local hospital and was later pronounced deceased. It is unknown if impairment was a factor.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears the electric bicycle rider was traveling north on Bushard Street when he lost control and struck the curb north of the intersection with Atlanta Avenue.

The collision investigation is ongoing and being handled by the HBPD Multidisciplinary Accident Investigation Team (MAIT). Anyone who may have witnessed the collision or the events leading up to it is encouraged to contact HBPD Traffic Investigator C. Houlston at (714) 536-5670.
