Fatal Traffic Collision - Magnolia Street and Atlanta Avenue

On Saturday, August 3, 2024, at approximately 6:30 AM, the Huntington Beach Police Department (HBPD) responded to a traffic collision on Magnolia Street and Atlanta Avenue involving a bicyclist and a 2018 Jeep Grand Cherokee.

Upon arrival, officers located the bicyclist, a 70-year-old male from Huntington Beach, with serious injuries. The driver of the Jeep, a 49-year-old female from Huntington Beach, was contacted at the scene. The bicyclist was transported to a local hospital and was later pronounced deceased. The driver of the Jeep cooperated with investigators, and impairment does not appear to be a factor. It is unknown if impairment was a factor with the rider of the bicycle.

Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears the bicyclist traveled through a red light southbound on Magnolia and collided with the Jeep traveling east on Atlanta.

The collision investigation is ongoing and being handled by the HBPD Multidisciplinary Accident Investigation Team (MAIT). Anyone who may have witnessed the collision or the events leading up to it is encouraged to contact HBPD Traffic Investigator C. Houlston at (714) 536-5670.
