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Fatal Traffic Collision – Beach Boulevard and Talbert Avenue

On Wednesday, April 16, 2025, at approximately 12:10 a.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department (HBPD) responded to a traffic collision involving a green Honda CRV and a pedestrian at the intersection of Beach Boulevard and Talbert Avenue.

Upon arrival, officers located the driver of the CRV, a 73-year-old male from Santa Ana, uninjured. The pedestrian, a 45-year-old male from Stanton, was found unconscious in the roadway. Paramedics were called to the scene; however, the pedestrian was later pronounced deceased. The driver of the CRV cooperated with investigators, and impairment does not appear to be a factor.

Based on the preliminary investigation, the CRV was traveling northbound on Beach Boulevard and struck the pedestrian north of the intersection of Talbert Avenue.

The collision investigation is ongoing and being handled by the HBPD Multidisciplinary Accident Investigation Team (MAIT). Anyone who may have witnessed the collision or the events leading up to it is encouraged to contact HBPD Traffic Investigator S. Flynn at (714) 536-5666.

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
