LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

State law requires all dogs over four months of age must be licensed.

The following documentation must be included with a license application:

RABIES VACCINATION: Verify that the rabies vaccination is current. You must send the rabies certificate, signed by an accredited veterinarian, with this application. The certificate will be returned with your new license. All licenses expire at the end of the month on the rabies vaccination anniversary. **To purchase a three year license, the vaccination must have occurred within the last six months.**

STERILIZATION CERTIFICATE: If applying for license for an animal that has been spayed or neutered a veterinarian's certification of sterilization is required. You must send the sterilization certificate with this application. The certificate will be returned with your new license.

- If the owner has moved to Michigan from another state more than 30 days ago and has not purchased a dog license.
- If the animal owner has been cited by an Animal Control Officer for failure to license their dog.
