

WHAT IS A KEY FOB SYSTEM?

A FOB is an electric 'key' that allows the locking mechanism on the gate to unlock, providing secure access to the Dog Park.

The FOB is used to exit the park as well.



Where Can I Purchase an Annual Pass to Soldan Dog Park?

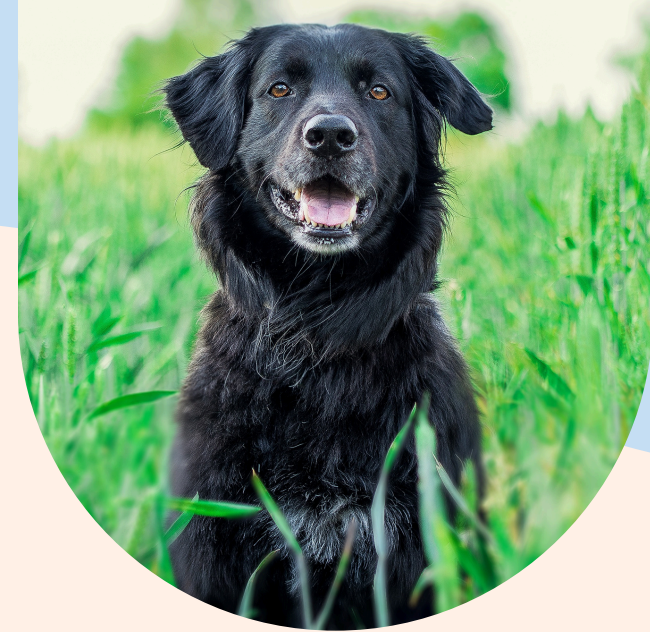

KEY FOB SYSTEM

Why is a FOB system necessary?

- Ensures dogs are licensed and vaccinated
- Secure facility for pets and their owners
- FOB Sales maintain and improve the park

WHAT'S IN THE DOG PARK?

- Secure Key FOB entry to fenced-in 15 acres of diverse natural area
- Large Pond
- Forested Trails
- Dog-waste bags provided
- Seasonal Dog washing station
- Seasonal Pet/Human drinking fountains



****Dog License and Proof of Rabies Vaccination Required****

Dog Park Fees:

- Twelve Month (Annual) Pass \$33
- Discount Twelve Month Pass (with ID) Student/Senior (60+)/Veteran/Service Animal \$22
- Daily Pass \$6 (Available ONLY when staff are present at the Hawk Island Gatehouse)

All fees collected go toward dog park improvements and maintenance of the dog park.

Hours of Operation:

Open year-round and operates the same hours as Hawk Island Park:
(8 am to sunset)
unless otherwise posted

****Vehicle Fees apply when entering Hawk Island****



DOG PARK RULES

All FOB holders must abide by posted rules.

These include but are not limited to:

- Use of the Dog Park is at your own risk
- Dogs must be under owner's control at all times (leashed or not)
- All dogs must be licensed and wear a license in the park
- Owners must pick up after their dogs
