## 12th Annual Jonesburg Lighted Christmas Parade to be held Friday, December 2nd, 2022

The Parade will begin at 6:00 P.M. from St. Patrick's Catholic Church parking lot. The parade will travel south on First Street, then turning on East Lions Street at the bank, turning south on to Jones Street at the Post Office, turning west onto Main Street where it will then travel past the Lions Park and end at Gladstone Ave. FOR SAFETY REASONS WE ASK THAT NO CANDY TO BE THROWN. If you plan on entering anything (float, car, truck, tractor, motorcycle etc.) in the parade remember it must be lit up and we encourage you to try to line up by 5:30 P.M. Parade line up will be at St. Patrick's Catholic Church parking lot. The Community Hall will NOT BE OPEN until immediately after the parade is over. We will have Santa's house set up again this year outside the Community Building where kids can get the picture taken for free and get a bag of candy. We will be serving free chili, hot dogs, nachos, popcorn, soda, and water in the Community Building. We will also be having Nick's Barnyard Buddies petting zoo back. It will be set up near Santa's house. At the end of the evening, we plan on having the big bike giveaway!
