AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SURFACE USE OF THE CHANNEL BETWEEN NORWAY LAKE AND WEST NORWAY LAKE

Be it ordained and enacted by the Kandiyohi County Board of Commissioners, State of Minnesota, that these amendments following, by this newly enacted ordinance, shall become the totality of Kandiyohi County Ordinance No _____

Section 1 PURPOSE, INTENT, AND APPLICATIONS: As authorized by Minnesota Statutes 86B 201, 86B 205, and 459 20 and Minnesota Rules 6110 3000 - 6110 3800 as now in effect and as hereafter amended, this Ordinance is enacted for the purpose and with the intent to control and regulate the use of the waters of Norway Lake, West Norway Lake, and the Channel between the two bodies of water in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, to promote its fullest use and enjoyment by the public in general and the citizens of Kandiyohi County in particular, to insure safety for persons and property in connection with the use of said waters, to harmonize and integrate the varying uses of said waters, and to promote the general safety and welfare of the citizens of Kandiyohi County, Minnesota

Section 2 DEFINITIONS:

- 1 'Motorboat' shall be defined as in Minnesota Statute 86B 005, Subd. 9
- 2 "Slow-no wake" shall be defined as in Minnesota Statute 86B 005, Subd. 16a
- 3 'Norway Lake - West Norway Lake' means the body of water designated lake number 34-251 by the Minnesota DNR
- 4 "Channel" is delineated on the attached map, and is a body of waters wholly within the territorial boundaries of Kandiyohi County

Section 3 SURFACE ZONING OF NORWAY LAKE - WEST NORWAY LAKE BY RESTRICTING SPEEDS ON THE CHANNEL BETWEEN NORWAY LAKE AND WEST NORWAY LAKE No motorboat shall be operated at greater than slow-no wake speed at any time within the area as marked by attached map

Section 4 ENFORCEMENT. The primary enforcement of this Ordinance shall be the responsibility of the peace officers of the Kandiyohi County Sheriff's Dept


Section 5 EXEMPTIONS All authorized resource management, emergency and enforcement personnel, while doing their jobs are exempt from the restrictions

Section 6 NOTIFICATION It shall be the responsibility of Kandiyohi County to provide for adequate notification of the public, which shall be the placement of a sign at each public watercraft access outlining essential elements of the ordinance, as well as placement of necessary buoys

Section 7 PENALTIES any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700.00) or by imprisonment of not more than ninety days (90) or both.

Section 8 EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon its publication, which publication shall follow passage and approval by the Board of Commissioners of Kandiyohi County and approval by the Commissioner of Natural Resources

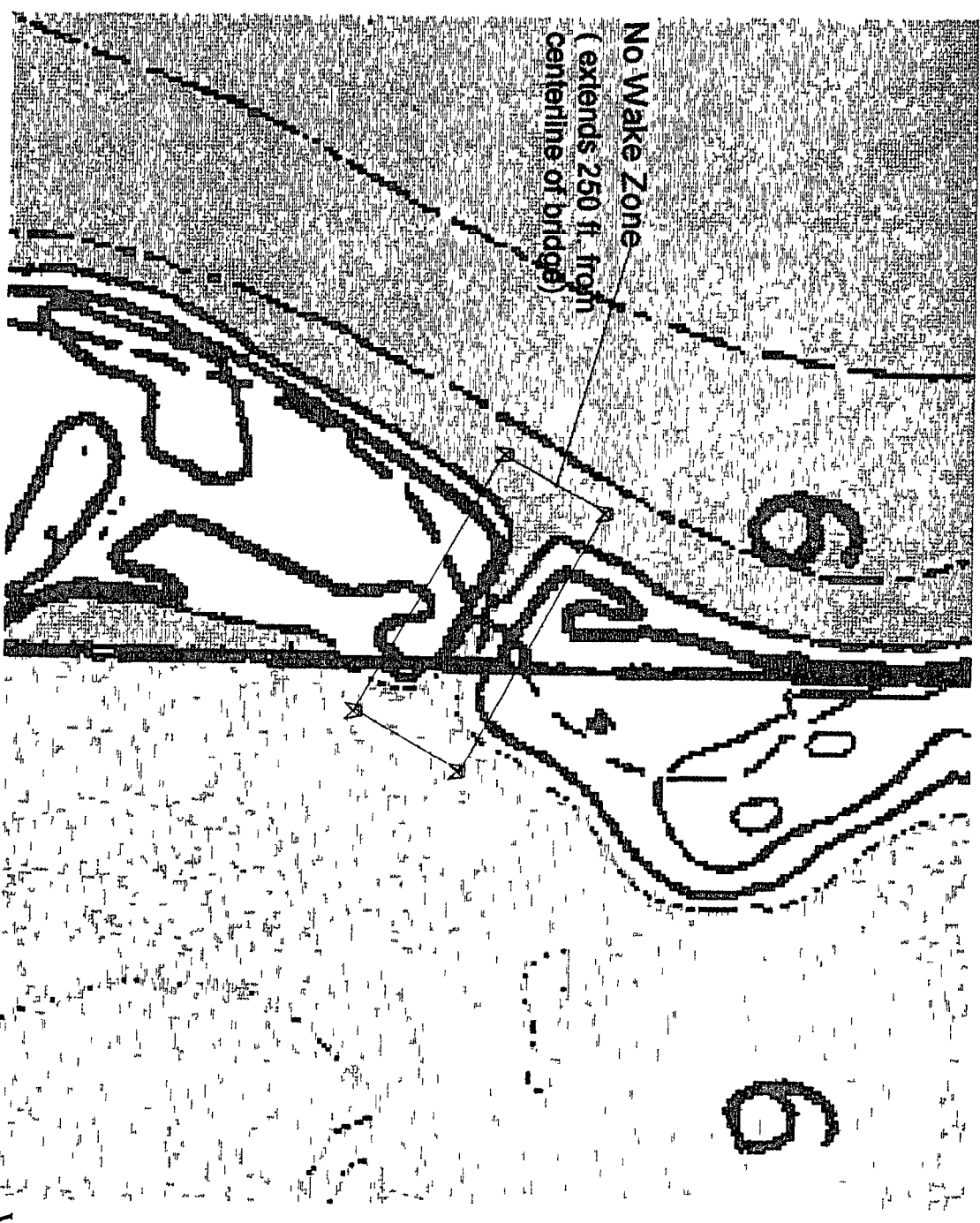

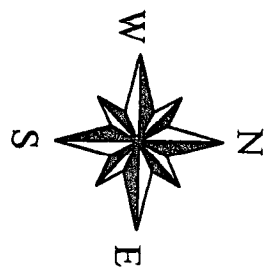

Norway Lake No Wake Zone and Buoy Locations

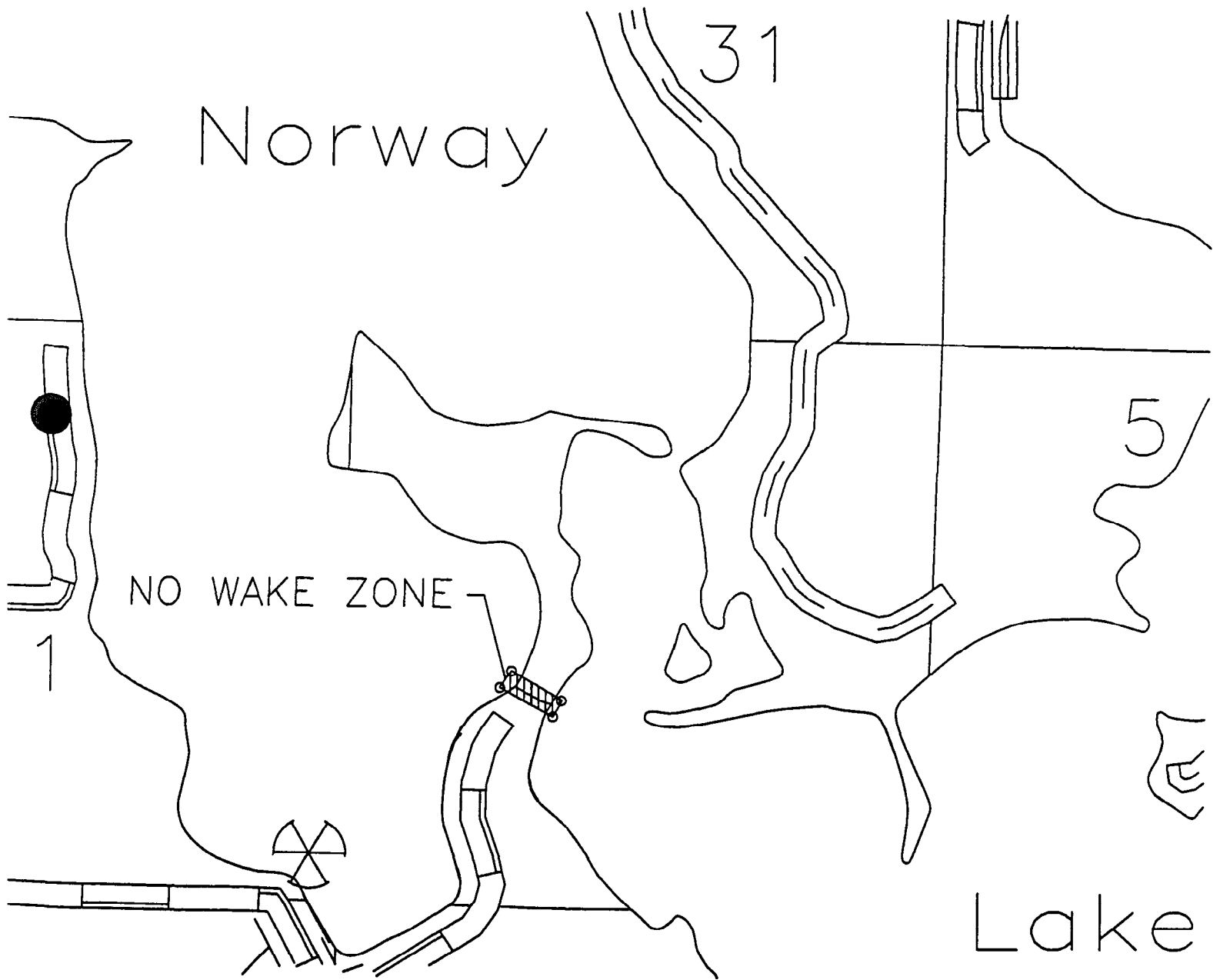


No Wake Zone

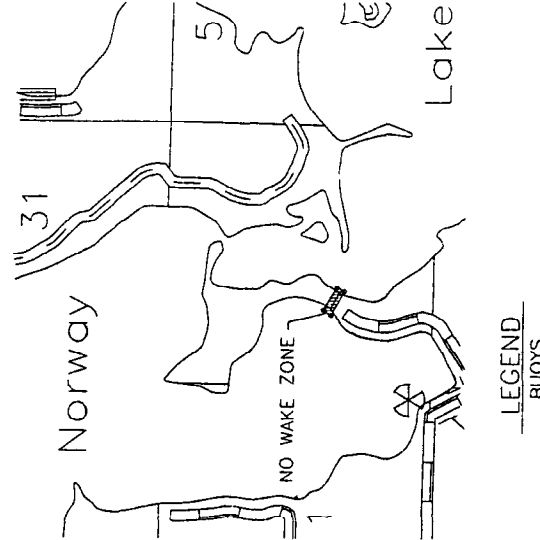

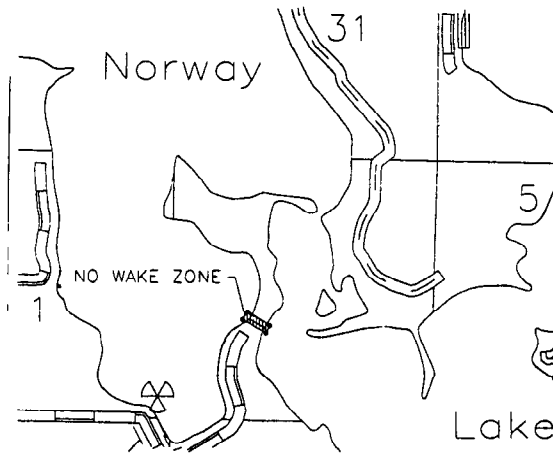
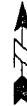
